## English Studies for Aviation

WIE's English Studies for Aviation has been developed specifically for those who work in the aviation industry and need to comply with the International Civil Aviation Organisation's (ICAO's) language proficiency requirements.

### The course aims to:

- Assist aviation students in reaching the required ICAO Level 4 of English language proficiency
- Build confidence with conversational skills and technical language needed for use during training and active duty
- Equip students with extended vocabulary and comprehension to ensure effective communication

### Why Study ESA at WIE?

This course is built around topics and themes within the context of aviation, with specific reference to and focus on the assessed elements of pronunciation, structure, vocabulary, fluency, comprehension and interactions.

Course presentations focus on 12 aviation-based themes, each containing a variety of topics specific to the technical language requirements of aviation.
