TOEIC Test Centre

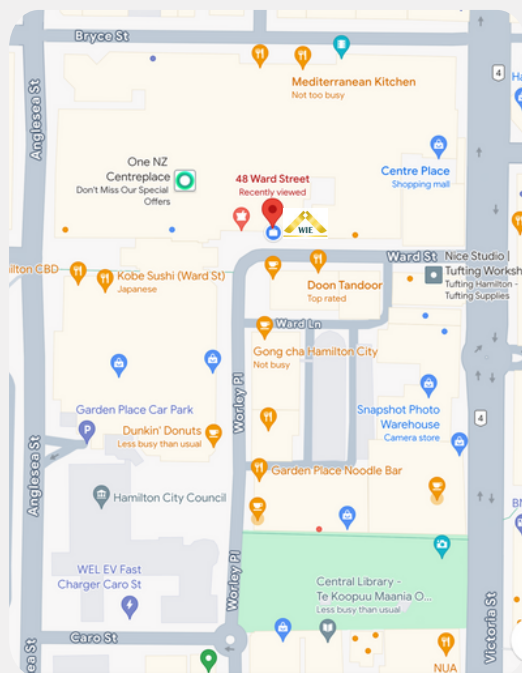
TOEIC (Test of English for International Communication) is the world's most popular test for Business English in the workplace, used by nearly 14,000 organisations in over 150 countries.

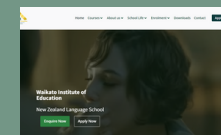
